

ISR (Intergroup Service Rep) Report for AGM (SL)

I am serving as the ISR for the UK Intergroup in my 2nd year. I represented the UK World Service Conference in August 2017 in Dallas and chose to serve on the Public Information Committee and International Caucus committees. I represent the UK at the European Intergroup monthly committee calls as well as annual in person meeting held this year in Worth. I hope to attend WSC this August in Minneapolis, US.

- I reported this at September Intergroup. "There is a projected deficit for DA in 2018 spending plan of \$26K. DA can't keep reducing its outgoings, the income must go up to support the spending plan. ***Can we review the amount (%) UK Inter-group contribute?*** "
- At WSC- there was a suggested plan to increase the income of DA was to increase the personal contributions. In 2017 there were \$15,600 in personal donations, which was from 48 members donating £21 (\$27) each month for a year. If DA could increase income, so out of our 5000 members, so if 148 members could donate £21 a month for a year, there would be no deficit in the projected spending plan for 2018 and DA finances would be in surplus. **Would you be able to give £21 to DA monthly? Can we in the UK set up donations from members to make this happen**

WSC Public Information

Attended monthly committee calls. Completed the White Board Video and approval process by GSB. Presented it at the UK convention in October and it is now on the US and UK website as well as other intergroup sites.

This year I am serving by helping to set up a fellowship wide call on 'how to carry the message in line with the traditions'-

we are awaiting date to be approved by GSB. There will be a UK dial in number.

Started to send out emails with new outreach letters to websites that offer support to people in debt and ask to be listed as a resource on their website.

Attended the **UK PI conference calls**, supporting One Member one action in April, changed the tab of Public Information to 'carrying the message'. UK intergroup made a £25 donation of literature to HMP Coldingley Prison.

WSC International Caucus-
